Bishop Galvin Central School is a vertical rural co-educational school with an enrolment of 219 pupils . It has a Catholic ethos and is under the patronage of the Catholic Bishop of Cork and Ross, Bishop Fintan Gavin. The Board of Management invites applications for the position of Principal commencing on August 29th 2024.

The present staff comprises of 9 mainstream teachers, 4 Special Educational teachers including 1 A.S.D. 5 S.N.A.'s and a fulltime secretary.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria: Fully registered under Route 1 ( Primary) with the Teaching Council and have 5 years recognised teaching service , two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland.
