Primary Purpose

The Maths tutor will be responsible for the delivery of the iScoil QQI Level 3 course in Mathematics (3N0929). The tutor will support learners with Maths, grade student work, create content as required on iScoil's virtual learning platform (VLE), work with mentors to support students, prepare student portfolios for QQI accreditation, and complete other duties as required.

The aim of the Maths course is to equip students with the knowledge, skills, and competence to solve mathematical problems. Students develop an understanding of mathematical applications in everyday life and develop skills and confidence that allow them to deal competently with mathematical problems and numeric challenges that they will encounter.
