International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)

- 50.1 per cent of grades at the equivalent of A*/A (grades 7-9 in the new GCSE framework), compared to 20.6 per cent of students across the UK achieving the same results.

A-levels

- 39 per cent of grades at A*/A, well above the global average of 25.2 per cent.
- 63.8 per cent of grades were A*/B for the year, also well above the global average of 51.1 per cent.

French Baccalaureate

- 100 per cent pass rate for the second year running from all three NAE schools offering this qualification: Collège Alpin Beau Soleil, Collège Champittet, Pully and Collège du Léman
- 32 per cent of students receiving "mentions très bien" for their diploma.
