This is a critical top management role.

Ã© Have at least five years' relevant postgraduate experience which must include at least three years' satisfactory service as a teacher at post-primary level (other relevant experience may include lecturing, relevant further study and / or educational research);

Ã© Have a proven record of accomplishment as a leader and senior manager with the ability to provide effective leadership and direction in a complex organisation within a constantly changing and frequently pressured environment;

Ã© Have the ability to contribute to the formulation of examination and assessment policy within the strategic direction and policy framework set by the Commission.
