This is a part time SNA position (6.5 hours per week). There will also be an opportunity to act as a substitute SNA to cover staff absences should the need arise.

The successful candidate will be involved in supporting children in both our mainstream classes and two ASD classes. Duties of the post are as outlined in the Department of Education Skills 0030/2014 and other relevant circulars. The post is subject to continued NCSE allocation and SENO review.

Applicants must demonstrate the specific competencies and requirements to meet the special educational and care needs of children.

Candidates are required to have minimum qualifications as set out by the DES Circular 0051/2019, though having Fetac Level 5/6 in SEN or other relevant qualifications in areas such as First Aid certification, ICT is desirable.

Candidates must be able to work well as part of a team, be flexible, display a strong work ethic, demonstrate a willingness to avail of further training, respect the ethos of the school and be willing to work under the direction of the class teachers, SET Co-Ordinator and school Principal. The ability to support children with challenging behaviour is essential. We are looking for someone who is energetic, enthusiastic and responsive to the needs of the children and the school.

Applicants should have experience and relevant qualifications in working with children with ASD,

ADHD, Down syndrome, Cerebral Palsy and children with behavioural needs.
