- Conduct primary and secondary research including quantitative research, statistical and trend analyses, qualitative research and literature reviews.
- Conduct evaluation research on NCSE/DE services and supports, in particular for new and pilot initiatives.
- Produce research reports of a publishable and accessible standard along with easy to read summaries.
- Prepare analytical and discussion papers on relevant special education and inclusion issues as required and also in response to reports, policy advice and submissions.
- Manage commissioned research as required, including tendering, contract and budget management, research review and quality assurance and preparing reports for publication.
- Plan for and oversee the dissemination of key outputs from the NCSE research to target audiences through a variety of means.
