Applicants must be fully registered with the Teaching Council and have a recognised qualification to teach religion in a Catholic School.

The current pupil population of Scoil Phádraig is 575 students. There are 23 mainstream classrooms as well as 3 ASD classes.

Scoil Phádraig has a professional and highly motivated staff, which, from September 2024 includes: an Admin DP, 39 teachers, 12 Special Needs Assistants, 2 secretaries, 2 cleaners and a caretaker.

Our pupils are actively engaged in their learning, inclusive of others and have a warmth towards their peers and staff. Scoil Phádraig is a school committed to the nurturing of positive relationships and the use of Restorative Practices. The atmosphere of the school is open and welcoming.
