Kildangan NS is a rural, vertical Catholic primary school in the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin. Bishop Denis Nulty is its Patron. The successful candidate will need to demonstrate a commitment to continue to lead and strengthen the Catholic ethos of the school. Applications must be fully registered with The Teaching Council and have a recognised qualification to teach religion in a Catholic School.

The current enrolment in Kildangan NS is 222 students. The highly motivated staff includes 15 teachers (Mainstream class teachers, Special Class teacher and SEN teachers), 5 SNAs, 2 part-time secretaries, a caretaker and 2 Bus Escorts.

Kildangan NS is a child-centred learning environment where everyone works together to provide a high quality education in a welcoming, happy and safe atmosphere.
