Additional Information:

Mount Sion Primary School, an Edmund Rice school, is a vertical all boys DEIS Band 1 school under the patronage of the Catholic Bishop of Waterford and Lismore, Alphonsus Cullinan.

The school seeks to appoint an Administrative Principal beginning on the 29/08/2024.

The present teaching staff comprises 1 Administrative Principal, 16 Class Teachers, 3 Special Class Teachers, 12 SETs and 1 HSCL Teacher. The school has 3 special classes for children with autism. The school is also a base for a Substitute Supply Panel of 4 teachers.

Applicants must be registered with the Teaching Council of Ireland (Route 1 - Primary), be fully Garda vetted and have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience in a recognised primary school in Ireland. The statutory functions of the Deputy Principal are set out in Sections 22 and 23 of the Education Act 1998.

The roles and responsibilities of the post of Deputy Principal Teacher are determined by the four domains of Leadership and Management as set out in chapter 4 of Circular 0044/2019.

- 1 Leading Teaching and Learning
- 2 Managing the Organisation
- 3 Leading School Development
- 4 Developing Leadership Capacity

In line with the above domains and working closely with the Principal, the duties attached to the

role involve SEN co-ordination, whole school curricular development, policy development, DEIS planning, day-to-day management of resources and personnel and long-term strategic planning for the future development of the school.

In addition, the successful candidate will demonstrate:

- An understanding and a commitment to the school's Catholic ethos and an ability to support and promote the ethos of the Edmund Rice Schools Trust (ERST). Applicants are required to hold a valid certificate to teach religion.
- An in-depth knowledge of the Primary Curriculum and a range of teaching experience.
- An understanding and knowledge of Special Education Needs, as well as a commitment to inclusion and diversity in education.
- Excellent people management and communication skills and demonstrate an ability to foster positive relationships with pupils, parents and the wider community.
- Proven leadership skills and a commitment to school self-evaluation
- A commitment to and evidence of relevant continuing professional development.

Candidates should be able to display evidence of an intimate understanding of DEIS and its implementation and the ability to foster the involvement of parents within the school community. The successful candidate will be an excellent communicator with the strong inter-personal skills that are required to lead and maintain a happy, active, and progressive school community. The appointment will be subject to current vetting requirements and occupational health screening.
