St. Joseph's N.S. is a Boys Primary School.

The school has a Catholic Ethos and is under the patronage of the Bishop of Clogher, Bishop Larry Duffy.

The Board of Management of St. Joseph's N.S. invites applications for the position of Principal. This is an administrative Principal role.

This is a permanent position, commencing on 27th August 2024. The appointment will be made via open competition under the terms of Circular 0044/2019.

The current teaching staff comprises of 10 Mainstream Class Teachers, 5 Special Education Teachers (one of whom is shared), 1 Permanent E.A.L. Teacher and 5 S.N.A.s.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria: Fully registered under Route 1 (Primary) with the Teaching Council and have 5 years recognised teaching service, two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland.
