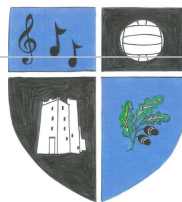

The school seeks to appoint an Administrative Principal beginning on Thursday 28th August 2025. The successful candidate will work collaboratively with the In-School Leadership and Management Team and staff to lead the school's next phase of development.

The present teaching staff comprises 1 Administrative Principal 13 Mainstream Class Teachers, 4 SETs and 2.83 SNA positions.

The roles and responsibilities for the post of Principal are aligned to the four Domains of Leadership and Management as specified in Circular 0044/2019.

Candidates should have an in-depth knowledge of and professional experience relevant to the four Domains and Standards contained in Looking At Our Schools 2022: A Quality Framework for Primary and Special Schools.

Applications are invited by email for the attention of the Chairperson of the Board of Management from teachers who are fully registered with the Teaching Council. Applicants must have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience in a primary school in Ireland and hold a Certificate to teach Religion.

The appointment will be subject to Garda Vetting, satisfactory references, Occupational Health Screening and the approval of the Patron.
