St Mary's Primary School is a vertical co-educational school under the patronage of the Catholic Bishop of Waterford and Lismore. The school seeks to appoint an Administrative Principal beginning on the 1st September 2025. From September 2025 the teaching staff will comprise of 1 Administrative Principal, 15 Mainstream Class Teachers and 2 Autism Special Classes (one of which is an Early Intervention class), 5 SEN teachers, 1 EAL teacher, 1 shared HSCL teacher. It currently has 8 SNAs.
