#### Additional Information:

The positions advertised are for Special Needs Assistants for Stratford National School. Stratford National School is a small, co-educational, multi-grade primary school in the heart of Rathgar, Dublin 6. The school shares a campus with Stratford College Co-educational Secondary School and has four mainstream classes, and two autism classes which opened in September 2023. It operates under the patronage of the Dublin Talmud Torah and has a Jewish ethos. Enrolment consists of pupils from a wide range of cultural backgrounds and the school welcomes children of all religions and none. Diversity and inclusion are cherished by the school.

There are three posts available:

- 1 fixed term position for a full day autism classroom
- 1 fixed term position for an infant day (0.83) early intervention classroom

 $\bullet$  1 job share fixed term position for an infant day (0.5 of a 0.83 position) – early intervention classroom

To meet the needs of the school the following competencies are desirable:

- Knowledge and experience of working with children with ASD and/or complex needs.
- Experience of working with children with challenging behaviour and promotion of positive behaviour strategies.
- Experience of working with children with mobility and/or toileting needs.
- Evidence of CPD in the area of Special Needs in relation to education.
- Child protection training and certification.

• Candidates must be able to work well within a team, display a strong work ethic, be flexible and

demonstrate a willingness to avail of further training.
