SKY ETNS is a small, developing co-educational vertical school which opened in September 2022 with 11 Junior Infants in one Mainstream and one Autism class. As of September 2025, we have pupils up to 2nd Class. By 2030 we will have 8 Mainstream Classes and 2 Special Autism Classes. The school is currently located in excellent standard temporary accommodation just 1.5km from our permanent site.

The Educate Together ethos is central to our school and its development. We are committed to promoting the voice of the child, partnership with parents in our community and celebrating inclusion, respect and diversity.
