Clonpriest N.S. is a Catholic, co-educational, inclusive and child-centred primary school. The current teaching staff comprises 6 mainstream class teachers, 3 SETs (including the Teaching Principal), and a dedicated team of SNAs.

We seek a Principal who will lead a dedicated and collaborative staff and who will work closely with the Board of Management, parents and the wider school community to ensure the continued development and success of the school.

The appointment process will be governed by the terms of Department of Education Circular 0044/2019. The roles and responsibilities of the post relate to the four domains of Leadership and Management set out in the Circular.

1. Leading Teaching and Learning
2. Managing the Organisation
3. Leading School Development
4. Developing Leadership Capacity

The successful candidate should demonstrate:

- A commitment to upholding the Catholic ethos, values and traditions of the school, and to fostering the positive, collaborative and supportive learning environment that currently exists within the school community.
- A strong understanding of the Primary Curriculum and of high-quality teaching and learning.
- Experience in the development, implementation and evaluation of school-based initiatives.
- A knowledge and understanding of special educational needs, along with a commitment to inclusion and diversity.
- Excellent people management and communication skills, with the ability to build and maintain strong relationships with staff, pupils, parents, Board of Management, other schools, wider

community and external agencies.

- The capacity to empower staff and promote distributed leadership and professional learning within the school.
- Evidence of ongoing professional development.

Minimum of 5 years recognised teaching experience, two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland.
