The successful candidate will play a central role in supporting the spiritual, pastoral and faith life of the school community. The Chaplain will work collaboratively with school leadership, staff, students and parents to foster a caring, inclusive and faith-centred environment grounded in the School's ethos.

The role will include:

- Leadership in the faith formation of students across all year groups
- Preparation and coordination of liturgical celebrations throughout the school year
- Organising school masses, prayer services, retreats and sacramental preparation
- Supporting students in their spiritual, emotional and pastoral development
- Providing a compassionate and visible pastoral presence within the school community
- Supporting students during times of bereavement, difficulty or crisis
- Collaborating with senior leadership, Year Heads, Guidance Counsellors and student support teams
- Assisting in the development of initiatives promoting wellbeing, inclusion and student voice
- Supporting and accompanying students in their leadership and charitable initiatives

- Teaching up to a maximum of eight hours per week of non-examination Religious Education classes
