Scoil Mhuire is a vibrant, inclusive, and welcoming co-educational primary school, committed to fostering a nurturing, supportive, and child-centred learning environment where every single pupil is encouraged to reach their full potential.

Currently there are 204 pupils on roll. The present staff comprises of an administrative principal, eight mainstream class teachers, two SET teachers, three special class teachers and nine SNAs.

The Board of Management of Scoil Mhuire invites applications from suitably qualified candidates for the position of Principal.

This is a permanent position to be appointed through open competition in line with Circular 0044/2019 from the start of the 2026 – 2027 academic year.

The appointment process will be governed by the terms of Circular 0044/2019. The roles and responsibilities for the post relate directly to the four domains of leadership and management as set out in Circular 0044/2019 and "Looking at our Schools 2022: A Quality Framework for Primary Schools and Special Schools":

- Proven leadership, administrative and management experience within a primary school setting. Along with excellent interpersonal, communication and people management skills.
- Extensive knowledge and experience in the area of special educational needs, together with a strong commitment to inclusion in education.
- A thorough knowledge and understanding of the Primary School Curriculum and of effective teaching and learning practices in a primary school setting.
- Experience in the development, implementation and evaluation of innovative school-based projects and policies.
- A proven ability to build and sustain positive, collaborative relationships with staff, pupils, parents, the Board of Management and external agencies.
- Evidence of continuing professional development, most particularly in the line of school leadership.
