We provide evidence-based, individualised educational and behavioural programmes tailored to the unique strengths and needs of each pupil. Our curriculum includes the Primary School Curriculum, as well as the L1LP/L2LP Junior Cycle and Senior Cycle programmes for post-primary pupils.

We are currently establishing a panel for permanent teaching posts that may arise during the summer, as well as fixed-term positions subject to sanction from the Department of Education and Youth (DEY) and the National Council for Special Education (NCSE).

Abacas is a wonderful place to work, with a highly supportive and collaborative team culture. Staff wellbeing, professional growth, and continuous learning are at the heart of our school community. Teachers benefit from supportive management, experienced colleagues, and access to regular Continuing Professional Development (CPD), mentoring, and opportunities for personal and professional development.
