The Deputy Principal will work in collaboration with the Principal to ensure that all students have a positive and meaningful educational experience; that there is strong leadership across the school and that the school fully conforms to the governance structures as set out by the Department of Education and Skills.

The Deputy Principal, along with the Principal and ISM Team, will model and develop a strong culture of mutual trust, respect, shared accountability and confidentiality.

The Deputy Principal must be willing to deputise for the Principal, as required.
